History of Changes to Phone Interview I

February 2001

- Expanded E14 (What hours did you work in the past week?) so that up to five different shifts could be accounted for. January 2001 version only had room for one set of hours, but it became apparent that the woman might have an irregular schedule.
- Dropped E15 (Work fixed or rotating shifts?). This information was never coded or entered.
- Expanded E22 (What hours did you work in the past week?) so that up to five different shifts could be accounted for. January 2001 version only had room for one set of hours, but it became apparent that the woman might have an irregular schedule.
- Dropped E23 (Work fixed or rotating shifts?). This information was never coded or entered.
- Section K (Interviewer Assessment of Interview) was reduced from four questions to three. K1 remained the same. K2 (quality of responses) and K3 (general comments about respondent) were combined to create an assessment of overall quality of interview, which became K2 of the revised questionnaire. K4 was renumbered to K3 and a response choice of “had poor memory” was added. Data from questionnaires with the four question version of Section K were entered into data entry system PI1.ent, while those with the three question version were entered into PI1v3.01.

9 May 2001

- Added column F27e (How Far?) to Child and Adult Care Activity Table. This column allowed for responses in terms of “Miles” or “Blocks.”

14 May 2001

- Added response option of “Feet” to F27e in Child and Adult Care Activity Table.
- Added response option of “Feet” to F29d in Walk for Transportation section.
- Added response option of “Feet” to F31d in Bike for Transportation section.

24 May 2001

- Changed response category options to D16 (Household income at time became pregnant), and renumbered as D16a. Response categories became narrower (see codebook or marked up version for details).
- Added D16b (Pre-tax total household income). This question is only answered if woman doesn’t know income or refuses in D16a.
- New database (PI1v4) was created into which these data could be entered.

15 November 2001

- Dropped F7 (stoop or squat at work); F8 (bend forward at work); F9 (twist to either side at work); F23 (stoop or squat while not at work); F24 (bend forward while not at work); F25 (twist to either side while not at work); F37 (how much time spent sleeping/trying to sleep); and F38 (how much time spent sitting/reclining).

19 November 2001

- Dropped F3 (how much time spent sitting at work); F4 (how much time sit at one time); F5 (how much time spent standing at work); F6 (how much time stand in one place); F19 (how much spent sitting while not at work); F20 (how much time sit at one time); F21 (how much time spent standing while not at work); and F22 (how much time stand in one place).
- Added F5a (how often stand at work), which has fixed response categories.
- New database (PI1v5) was created into which these data could be entered.

2 January 2002

- Dropped entry of text for G11 (What did doctor/nurse recommend?). Created new flag variable for whether text needs to be entered into Excel for this question.
- Dropped entry of text for G12 (Follow doctor/nurse’s advice?). Created new flag variable for whether text needs to be entered into Excel for this question.

- Dropped entry of text for H11 (Other type of abortion procedure). Created new flag variable for whether text needs to be entered into Excel for this question.

1 March 2002

- Categories in D16b were updated to reflect 2002 poverty line. No new database was created as the percentage is of importance, not the actual numbers.

24 April 2002

- Pre-pregnancy weight questions (B2a-B2j) were added.
- New database (PI1v6) was created into which these data could be entered.

4 December 2002

- Implemented skip of K3 (variables PI1K04A-PI1K04L) if answer in K2 (PI1K02A) was “high” or “generally reliable.” Prior to this date, if either of these answers were given in K2, then PI1K04A-PI1K04L were filled with 0s instead of 7s.
