## History of Changes to Phone Interview II

Earliest versions (prior to 27 March 2001)

- Dropped D17 (fixed or rotating schedule). This question was never coded or entered. Numbering change so that every question shifted up (e.g., D18 changed to D17, D19 changed to D18).
- Dropped D25 (fixed or rotating schedule). This question was never coded or entered. Numbering change so that every question shifted up (e.g., D26 changed to D24, D27 changed to D25).
- Dropped D37 (fixed or rotating schedule). This question was never coded or entered.
- Dropped questions from Section E, Health Counseling: Exercise, including the knowledge section that ended up in SAQ2. These questions were not coded or entered.
- Dropped questions from Section E, Health Counseling: Weight Gain. These questions were never coded or entered.
- Dropped J8-J12 and J20-J22, all questions about racial discrimination. These questions were never coded or entered. J13 changed to J8, J14 changed to J9, J15 changed to J10, J16 changed to J11, J17 changed to J12, J18 changed to J13, J19 changed to J14, J23 changed to J15, J24 changed to J16, J25 changed to J17, J26 changed to J18, J27 changed to J19, J28 changed to J20, J29 changed to J21. Variable names and ordering reflect the new numbering scheme because they were created using 9 May 2001 version of questionnaire.
- Dropped K33-K45, all questions about neighborhood. These questions were never coded or entered.

27 March 2001

- Dropped F4 (dealt successfully with life's hassles), F5 (dealt successfully with important life changes), F12 (thinking about things have to accomplish), F13 (able to control way spend time) from Cohen Perceived Stress scale. These questions were never coded or entered in prior versions. F6 changed to F4, F7 changed to F5, F8 changed to F6, F9 changed to F7, F10 changed to F8, F11 changed to F9, F14 changed to F10, F15 changed to F11, F16 changed to F12, F17 changed to F13, F18 changed to F14, F19 changed to F15, F20 changed to F16, F21 changed to F17, F22 changed to F18, F23 changed to F19, F24 changed to F20, F25 changed to F21, F26 changed to F22, F27 changed to F23, F28 changed to F24, F29 changed to F25, F30 changed to F26, F31 changed to F27, F32 changed to F28, F33 changed to F29, F34 changed to F30, F35 changed to F31. - Added Economic Assistance questions (G1-G6b). Earlier versions have the values for these variables coded as missing. Food Security section was not renumbered.

9 May 2001

- Ordering change occurred in Job # 1. D16 (what hours did you work) was expanded to allow for five different shifts. This question also was moved to become D11. D11 changed to D12, D12 changed to D13, D13 changed to D14, D14 changed to D15, D15 changed to D16. Variable names reflect this new numbering scheme, as this was the questionnaire used to develop the naming convention.
- Ordering change occurred in Job # 2. D23 (what hours did you work) was expanded to allow for five different shifts. This question also was moved to become D18. D18 changed to D19, D19 changed to D20, D20 changed to D21, D21 changed to D22, D22 changed to D23. Variable names reflect this new numbering scheme, as this was the questionnaire used to develop the naming convention.
- Ordering change occurred in Job # 1A. D34 (what hours did you work) was expanded to allow for five different shifts. This question also was moved to become D27. D27 changed to D28, D28 changed to D29, D29 changed to D30, D30 changed to D31, D31 changed to D32, D32 changed to D33, D33 changed to D34. Variable names reflect this new numbering scheme, as this was the questionnaire used to develop the naming convention.
- Added column E27e (How Far?) to Child and Adult Care Activity section. This column contained response spaces for Miles and Blocks. This column is coded as missing for those earlier questionnaires that should have had a response to this column.

14 May 2001

- Added response option of Feet to E27e (How Far?) of Child and Adult Care Activity section.
- Added response option of Feet to E29d (How Far?) of Walk for Transportation section.

- Added response option of Feet to E31d (How Far?) of Bike for Transportation section.
- Renumbered Food Security section. Variable names reflect 9 May 2001 numbering scheme. G1 changed to G9, G2 changed to G10, G3 changed to G11, G4 changed to G12, G5 changed to G13, G6 changed to G14, G7 changed to G15, G7a changed to G15a, G7b changed to G15b, G8 changed to G16, G9 changed to G17, G10 changed to G18, G11 changed to G19, G11a changed to G19a, G11b changed to G19b, G12 changed to G20, G13 changed to G21, G13a changed to G21a, G14 changed to G22, G15 changed to G23.

#### 15 November 2001

- Dropped E7 (how often stoop or squat at work); E8 (how often bend forward while standing at work); E9 (how often twist to either side at work); E23 (how often stoop or squat while not at work); E24 (how often bend forward while standing while not at work); E25 (how often twist to either side while not at work); E37 (how much time spent sleeping/trying to sleep); E38 (how much time spent sitting/reclining).

#### 19 November 2001

- Dropped E3 (how much time spent sitting at work); E4 (how long sit at one time); E5 (how long spend standing while at work); E6 (how long stand in one place at work).
- Added fixed response option question E5a (how often stand at work).
- Dropped E19 (how much time spent sitting while not at work); E20 (how long sit at one time); E21 (how much time spent standing while not at work); E22 (how long stand in one place).
- New database (PI2v2) was created into which these data could be entered.

#### 24 April 2002

- Added Pregnancy and Weight-Gain Attitude Scale to Section E. This scale is comprised of 18 questions (E50a-E50t). Also added text field for F28.

#### 22 January 2003 (No new version date- use date of interview to determine!)

- Phone Interview II reference point anchored to best available start of pregnancy date rather than start of pregnancy used in Phone Interview I.

#### 18 March 2003

- Manner in which participant's work schedule information was recorded and entered changed. Prior to this date, the total number of days that a particular shift was worked was entered. Now, the particular days of the week that were worked with a particular set of hours is entered. Data for interviews that were collected prior to this date were reassessed so as to be able to enter the data in this fashion. A total of 106 new variables were added. The old variables for the work schedule were dropped.

#### 18 August 2003

- Dropped E32-E34, which asked about whether woman walked 10 minute at a time with no increase in breathing/heart rate, how often she did so, and how much total time she spent walking in a day.
- New database (PI2v5) created.

#### 3 November 2003

- Dropped J1-J7 about experiences of racism because of problems with these questions identified by the interviewer.
